Road Restrictions

Due to the current weather we are experiencing in our area, the Village of Macoun would like to request the public use their best judgment when using roads within Village limits. Appleton Ave, main road, is not designed as a through road for heavy vehicles or oil, farm equipment.

Village Traffic Bylaw No. 12.21 states:

- 5. Heavy Vehicle Routes:
- 5.1 All streets in the Village of Macoun as set out in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw shall be known as the Heavy Vehicle Route and;
- a. Are only accessible to operators travelling to access the fuel tanks at the Macoun Co-op gas station located at 447 Appleton Ave; and
- b. No operator of a heavy vehicle shall access Range Road 2102 north / south or Township Road 44 east / west by travelling through the Village of Macoun on any street.

Road conditions and traffic will be monitored closely by staff and may result in the Village implementing road bans within Village limits. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter.

Pet Owners

Reminder for all pet owners that you are responsible for cleaning up after your pets. This means cleaning up your pets' feces while out walking as well as cleaning up your yard in a timely manner to prevent the smell from becoming a nuisance to your neighbors. All dogs and cats MUST be on a leash when off the property of its owner and are to be licensed with the Village of Macoun.
