Water's On

Water is back on at the Rec Centre for everyone's use. This source is completely free and also contains no harmful chemicals when using it for lawns and gardens. Please remember you cannot use water from your taps for washing vehicles, filling pools or watering lawns so use of the Rec Centre's water is a great solution.

Hydrant Flushing

Stan will start regular hydrant flushing this month. If you are on the H2 Notify system you will be advised when the flushing is occurring in your neighbourhood. After flushing if you notice your tap water is discolored run **COLD** water for a few minutes and it will rectify the situation. Never run warm water as particles could be forced into your hot water tank that could cause damage.

Trouble Making Payments??

The Village works with individuals if they are struggling with payments—often setting up a plan makes managing easier for you. All conversations with the Village are confidential and we welcome you to come have a chat.

Paying your taxes early provides you with a discount on municipal taxes – school taxes do not offer same. Taxes paid by:

September 30 th	5% Discount	October 31 st	4% Discount
November 30 th	2% Discount	December 31 st	Full tax amount due

Any taxes or utilities owing after the end of year are subject to interest penalties.
