## Bylaw 10-13

## A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MACOUN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE USE OF RECREATON VEHICLES WITHIN VILLAGE LIMITS

The COUNCIL of the Village of Macoun, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw, the expression:
- a. "Local Governing Authority" means the council of the Village of Macoun;
- b. "Campground" means a site operated and occupied as temporary accommodations for for camping units. A campground is not mobile home park, motel or hotel.
  - c. "Recreation Vehicle(RV)" means a vehicle primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreation camping, travel or seasonal use that is either self-powered, mounted on, or towed by another vehicle. "Recreational Vehicle" includes, but is not limited to, a camping trailer, fifth-wheel trailer, travel trailer, and truck camper.
  - 2. This bylaw shall apply to all areas within the corporate limits of the Village of Macoun.
- 3. No person in lawful possession or control of a site shall allow or permit a recreation vehicle parked on such site to be used for living or sleeping accommodations except as follows:
- a. A trailer parked in an approved campground.
  - b. the owner of the site has obtained approval from the Local Governing Authority.
  - 4. No person shall park a recreational vehicle on a municipal road or the front yard of any dwelling within the Village limits.
  - 5. Recreational Vehicles may be parked on driveways or designated area in the yard of dwelling upon consent of the property owner for storage purposes.
- 6. Upon approval of Local Governing Authority, owners of recreational vehicles may park RV on site owners property for 7 days maximum.
  - 7. Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be subject to a fine of \$500.
