

VILLAGE OF MACOUN

BYLAW NO. 2/01

A By-law of the Village of Macoun in the Province of Saskatchewan to regulate the burning of refuse within the boundaries of the Village of Macoun.

The Council of the Village of Macoun in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the authority of the Saskatchewan Clean Air Act, Section 18, hereby enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS 1. All terms and expressions used in this bylaw shall have the same respective meanings as in Section 11 of the Clean Air Regulations.

PROHIBITION 2. No person shall cause or permit to be caused the open burning of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste or any other material or waste in an open fire or in an incinerator in a manner that causes air pollution within the boundaries of the Village of Macoun.

INCINERATORS 3. No person shall cause or permit to be caused the burning of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste or any other waste material in a manner or in an incinerator other than that approved by the Department of Environment and Resource Management.

EXCLUSIONS 4. Sections 2 and 3 of this bylaw so not apply to:
a) An outdoor fire pit or outdoor fireplace covered with a metal grate and used for recreational purposes;
b) an outdoor fire using charcoal, processed coal or coke for cooking purposes.
c) The burning of brush for the purpose of clearing land for cultivation or for a
d) roadway, railway line, pipeline or any other right of way; and
a fire for the purpose of burning weeds, the prevention and control of fires or training of persons for fire fighting, if the fire is specially authorized or required pursuant to any Act, Act of Parliament or bylaw of a Municipality.

SAFETY 5. The above fires must have adult supervision at all times.

PENALTIES 7. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on a summary conviction to the penalties set out in The Urban Municipality Act 1984 or the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Macoun.
