

Bylaw No. 2.18

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MACOUN TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE BEFORE DIGGING WITHIN VILLAGE LIMITS AND PERFORMANCE DEPOSIT PROCEDURES.

COUNCIL of the Village of Macoun, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Notice must be given to the Village of Macoun Office five (5) working days before digging within Village limits.
2. Notice may be considered given by leaving a drawing of the proposed digging and contact information at the Village office and an application for a Contractor's License in the form of Appendix "A", has been completed and returned to the Village office.
3. Work may proceed once contacted by the Village office in regards to any Village owned lines in the area where the digging is to occur.
4. A Village representative must be present during all digging within Village limits.
5. A performance deposit may be requested to ensure compliance with any development standards. Deposits shall be required alongside a building permit when any ground disturbance is to take place on Village owned land(s). The performance deposit amount will be calculated as 10% of total estimated value of construction, to a maximum of \$5,000. The deposit will be collected at the same time as the Building Permit fee. The deposit will be returned in its entirety when the following conditions are met:
 - The applicant has requested a final inspection of the construction site;
 - All conditions of the permit have been completed to the satisfaction of either the Development Officer or Building Official;
 - The project has been completed within one (1) year of the permit issuance.Any performance deposit held for a period greater than one (1) year will be forfeited to the Village. Any applicant may make a request in writing to extend the period by one (1) year. All requests must be made within the end of the given time frame.
6. Bylaw No. 6/08 is hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.

- conform, in every respect, to Village bylaws and the Government of Saskatchewan in respect of approvals, permits, inspections and street closure
- to guarantee all work free from defects in workmanship for one (1) year from the date of final approval
